### **Conditions of Application**

All visual art forms will be considered: painting, drawing, mixed media, photography, printmaking, sculpture, fibre, glass, jewellery, ceramics, metal, woodwork and digital media. Work must be original. It will not be considered if made from patterns, kits or done in a class or workshop. Artwork must be ready for hanging or display (ie. framed & with appropriate hanging wire) with an identification label attached to the back of the work. Hanging wire is installed at least 3" from top of frame. Digital media must be on a USB flash drive. ( Gallery can supply digital streamer and a large flat screen TV.) All selected work must remain in the Gallery for the duration of the Exhibition. The Colborne Art Gallery will handle all sales of artwork and remit the Artist's portion minus the Gallery's 25% at the end of the exhibition. Please allow up to two weeks for processing. The Colborne Art Gallery is not responsible for insurance coverage against loss or damage to artwork. You may want to secure your own insurance for the work during the

exhibition. The Gallery may photograph selected works for promotional & reference purposes. Final exhibition decisions are at the discretion of the Colborne Art Gallery. **Juror:** Kim-Lee Kho Multidisciplinary Artist & Art Educator Kim-Lee Kho is a multidisciplinary artist whose artistic practice encompasses 2D, 3D, installation, video and performance, working with traditional, digital and hybrid media. She is also a popular teacher, speaker and juror, which she has done at the invitation of art groups around southern Ontario for over 10 years. Kho teaches regularly at Neilson Park Creative Centre in Toronto and the Haliburton School of Art + Design. Her broad experience with media, genres and formats informs her jurying process. **Label Format:** Images must be labelled as follows:

### **PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!**

Up to 3 attached images for submission (\$20 per image).

Image files must be labelled in the following format including commas and not to exceed a file size of 2 Mb. Surname, given name, image#, title, medium, size (WxH), completion date.

**Example (no spaces):** Smith,John,#1,Springtime,oil,36x36,2020

Please include your full name, mailing address, email & phone number where you can be reached with the list of your submissions. \*Including sale price as all selected artworks must be offered for sale. Images of artwork must be photographed clearly & accurately & only the work itself is to be within the photo. (ie. no glass reflection, background etc. or frames.) Images must be jpg format, straight photos with good lighting. If you are unfamiliar with how to photograph artwork for juried submission ask a photographer or artist friend. (Also, the internet is a valuable resource as there are several free sites that show how to crop images, adjust colour, etc.) Maximum size for wall art (including frame) is 36" wide with no height restriction. Sculpture/installation pieces should be easily handled by two people (jurors' discretion) Floor space available is 36" square. The maximum pedestal size available is 24" square. Digital media/videos: 15 min. or less. A submission fee of \$20 for each submitted artwork is non-refundable and is made at our web site using our PayPal function. ([www.thecolborneartgallery.ca](http://www.thecolborneartgallery.ca)) Other payment methods will not be accepted. Payments must be made on the day of your submission in order for your work to be presented to the Juror. You will be contacted by phone on or before May 11th if accepted. A confirmation email will be sent to you with label forms to be attached to the back of your work.
