**WHO MAY ENTER:**

OPEN to all emerging and established artists (CAG members excluded).

**LOCATION:** The Colborne Art Gallery, 51 King St. E, Colborne, ON provides a unique light-filled space in an historic building where your artwork will be viewed by our loyal patrons and friends.

**1. CONDITIONS OF APPLICATION:**

- All visual art forms will be considered: painting, drawing, mixed media, photography, digital art, printmaking, sculpture, fibre, glass, jewellery, ceramics, metal, woodwork.
- Work must be original. It will not be considered if made from patterns, kits or done in a class or workshop.
- **Work must have been completed within the last 3 years of this current exhibition.**
- Work accepted in a previous CAG juried show, or previously shown at the CAG Gallery, is not eligible.

**2. ENTRY FEES:**

- **\$40 for 1 entry, \$50 for 2 entries, \$60 for 3 entries**
- Entry fees are non-refundable.
- Payment of entry fees: on-line through the **PayPal portal**.
- **Upon receipt by CAG of your on-line submission, you will receive 2 verifications, 1 for your entry, 1 for successful payment.** Your registration is then considered confirmed as received. *There will not be additional correspondence of confirmation.*

**3. SUBMISSIONS:**

- **OPENS: Wednesday, May 1, 2024 at 8:00 am.**
- **CLOSES: Wednesday, July 31, 2024, at 12:00 midnight.**
- Submissions **MUST** be uploaded via the CAG Website on-line registration and submissions form. **Maximum size is 2 MB and 1200 pixels longest side.** If images do not meet these size requirements, they will not be sent to the

juror for consideration. (Note that the best resolution is 300 dpi for viewing magnified details, but this is not a requirement.)

- Correctly submitted Images will be forwarded to the juror following the close of submissions. **Artists will be contacted via email by August 19, 2024 regarding their status of acceptance.**

#### 4. AWARDS:

- Ethal Maclean Legacy Award - Best in Show - \$500
- Honourable Mention - \$300
- Mayor's Award - \$200
- John Stubbs Legacy Award - People's Choice - \$100

#### 6. ARTWORKS:

- **Maximum size** for wall art (including frame) is **36" wide with no height restrictions**. Artwork must be ready for display or hanging (gallery canvas, or framed work, wired on **LARGE 'D' hooks**. (Install wire at least 3" below the top of frame.)
- Attach identification information (**artist, title, medium, price, contact information**) to the back of the work.
- Sculpture/installation pieces should be easily handled by two people (juror's discretion). Floor space available is 36" square. The maximum pedestal size available is 24" square.

#### 7. DELIVERY OF SELECTED ART:

- Deliver to the Colborne Art Gallery, 51 King St., E, Colborne, ON
- **DELIVERY: Sunday September 8 (12 - 4 p.m.)**
- **PICK-UP: Sunday, November 3 (12 – 4 p.m.)** Selected artwork **MUST** be picked up at the end of the show. ***We cannot store artwork.***
- **All selected artworks must be for sale and remain in the Gallery for the duration of the exhibition.**

#### 8. FINAL REMARKS:

- The Colborne Art Gallery will handle all sales of artwork and remit the artist's portion minus the Gallery's 25% commission at the end of the exhibition. Please allow up to two weeks for processing.
- Should the need arise, artists are responsible for arranging delivery with the buyer for all sold works.
- The Colborne Art Gallery is not responsible for insurance coverage against loss or damage to artwork. You may want to secure your own insurance for the work during the exhibition.
- The Gallery may photograph selected works for promotional & reference purposes.
- Final exhibition decisions are at the discretion of the Colborne Art Gallery.
